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## 2018 Annual NAFSA Conference

The U.S. Commercial Service has once again secured a large “USA Pavilion” space for NAFSA 2018 in Philadelphia, May 27-June 1.

Study California, as one of 12 Study State Consortia will participate. Study State Consortia will have meeting kiosks along the outside rows of the Pavilion space with US Commercial Service Officers having their tables doing up the middle of the space.

Included with our participation fee:

- Two page insert in the USA Pavilion brochure which will be specially printed for the event
- Opportunity for 1-1 Showtime meetings with US Commercial Service Specialists from 13 countries
- \*Pre-scheduled E2E-Educator to Educator meetings with international universities and organizations (last year we had 47 meetings scheduled from 12 countries).
- Education USA is adjacent with their own pavilion area

The next USA Pavilion 2018 planning meeting is on Jan. 11<sup>th</sup>.
